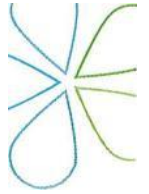

D6 Family Theme: INTEGRITY

The point: **Integrity means trusting God in every circumstance.**

Listen to God: Read Job 1:1-5

The book of Job opens with a description of Job's character and introduces him as a man blessed with a large family and many possessions. Lead your family in a discussion about what it means to fear God. (To fear God is to approach Him with deep respect and humble obedience.) Job apparently had a lot to be distracted with, but his focus remained on the Lord and living for Him.

Talk to God

Job took seriously his role as the spiritual leader of the family, and he did what was necessary to preserve the integrity of the home. He wanted to pass on his fear of the Lord to the next generation. Pray together for discernment as you navigate the many options the world presents your family for entertainment and enjoyment. Ask God to help your family turn away from evil and make choices that help you focus on the Lord and the teachings from His Word.

Walk With God

Option 1: Job did not just try to live a good life; he was intentional in his everyday life to guard against evil influences. Make a list of the ways your family regularly spends leisure time. Identify television shows or lyrics to songs that might contradict God's Word. Encourage your family to identify activities that represent or promote integrity and strong character. Challenge each family member to add more of those activities to the daily schedule and look for things that need to be taken out of it.

Option 2: Suffering is not necessarily a punishment from God. There is a greater purpose behind the events in our lives. Ultimately, God deserves all glory and can use each situation in life to achieve that goal. Encourage family members to share testimony about how they have experienced God's presence and teaching during their various trials.

Discuss the following questions: *What does it mean to bring glory to God? How can our family's life of integrity bring God glory?*
